MAJOR INCIDENTS/INVESTIGATIONS/ISSUES

On 3-26-08 at 2300 hrs officers were dispatched to 2122 Woodlawn on a report of arson. Upon officers arrival they observed a vacant house on fire. It appeared that all accidental causes could be ruled out. The investigation continues. There was another possible arson close by which may be related.

On 3-29-08 at 1350 hrs officers were dispatched to 4626 Garvok Ct. on a report of a robbery. Upon arrival the officers determined that a B/M wearing dark clothing with a tan mask walked up to the victim while he was working on his car and showed him a gun and told him to give him money. The victim had no money and the suspect ran away.

On 3-30-08 at 2258 hrs at 2964 S Keystone at the Village Pantry officers were dispatched on a report of an armed robbery. Upon arrival the victim stated that a W/M 6'5", 200 lbs, black hoodie, sunglasses, entered the store and told the clerk to open the register. The suspect fled in a white full size pickup truck.

On 3-31-08 at 0110 hrs at 4903 Brookville Rd., officers were dispatched on a report of an armed robbery. Upon arrival the victim stated that he had been partying in his garage when one of the subjects became upset and forced him into his own house and made him give up his coin collection. He knows the subject and the investigation continues.

MAJOR PERSONNEL AND/OR DISCIPLINARY ISSUES

Currently we have 0 officer injured on duty, 8 detailed or training, 2 officers sick, 0 officer suspended, and 0 sick civilian.

SUMMARIES OF VIOLENT CRIMES

On 3-26-08 at 615 E Thompson Rd. at 1732 hrs an officer observed a vehicle driving reckless so he initiated a traffic stop and determined that a subject laying in the back of the vehicle had been shot. After the victim was transported to the hospital one of the subjects in the car was arrested for criminal recklessness with a handgun.

On 4-1-08 at 1200 hrs at 1540 Brookville Crossing Way officers were notified that a girl under the age of consent had been having sexual relations with an adult male. Detectives were notified and the investigation is continuing.

On 4-3-08 at 1938 hrs officers were dispatched to 1605 Wade St. on a report of a possible arson. The homeowner stated that he found several paper fliers from a local business spray painted and scattered in his front yard. Some of them appeared to be burnt. Someone may have attempted to start a fire in the bushes directly in front of his house.
